

IV Sunday in Ordinary Time

World Interfaith Harmony Week, February 1 to 7, 2026

World Interfaith Harmony Week was adopted by the United Nations on October 20, 2010, designating the first week of February each year for its observance. The initiative invites people of all faiths, as well as those of goodwill, to engage in dialogue grounded in two moral principles: love of God and love of neighbour, without compromising individual religious convictions.
“The Church exhorts her sons and daughters, that through dialogue and

collaboration with the followers of other religions, carried out with prudence and love and in witness to the Christian faith and life, they recognize, preserve, and promote the good things, spiritual and moral, as well as the socio-cultural values found among them.” (Nostra aetate §2)

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week, must be requested by **Wednesday of each week at office closing time or 4:00pm**. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. **Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name**. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.
The following are required at St. Jude's:
♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year. requirements before making your request.
It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a recommendation letter from your Pastor.
