

Confessions
The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program
Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony
Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's Parish are asked to contact the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

XIX Sunday in Ordinary Time
“*Blessed are those slaves whom the master finds alert when he comes*”
In today’s Gospel we see Jesus addressing his disciples and us, in a very tender way, telling us: “*Do not be afraid, my little flock*” (Lk 12, 32). The reason for not fearing is that the Father has seen fit to give us the Kingdom, a kingdom that begins now, that we are now building on earth sowing love, justice, peace, reconciliation and truth, just as we have and the joy of belonging to it; although we know that the Kingdom in its fullness will only be after this world that passes. For this reason, the Lord Jesus exhorts us to store up a treasure in heaven, a treasure that does not end, where the thief does not come, nor does the moth destroy it. Jesus says: “*where your treasure is, there your heart will be*” (Lk 12, 34). So where is your treasure? If it is here on earth, you will go through many anguishes to protect it and to increase it; but if you have it in heaven, you will live in peace and without fright, increasing it more. The Lord in the parable invites us to be prepared for the moment when he comes to meet us, to open the door for him as soon as he arrives; upon arrival, the same master will pick up his tunic to sit them at the table and serve them. The Lord will serve us in the eternal banquet, when we arrive next to him; although it is wonderful that now from this world, he serves us in the person of his priests, his own Body as food for the journey in each Eucharist. That is why Jesus tells us every Sunday, people of God: get up and eat, because the road is long!


XIX Domenica del Tempo Ordinario
«*Beati quei servi che il padrone al suo ritorno troverà ancora svegli*».
Nel Vangelo di oggi vediamo Gesù rivolgersi ai suoi discepoli e a noi, con grande tenerezza, dicendoci: «*Non temere, mio piccolo gregge*» (Lc 12,32). Il motivo per cui non temiamo è che il Padre ha ritenuto opportuno donarci il Regno, un regno che inizia ora, che stiamo costruendo sulla terra seminando amore, giustizia, pace, riconciliazione e verità, proprio come noi e la gioia di appartenergli; pur sapendo che il Regno nella sua pienezza sarà solo dopo questo mondo che passa. Per questo motivo, il Signore Gesù ci esorta ad accumulare un tesoro in cielo, un tesoro che non finisce, dove non arriva il ladro, né la tignola lo consuma. Gesù dice: «*Dov'è il tuo tesoro, là sarà il tuo cuore*» (Lc 12,34).

Allora, dov'è il tuo tesoro? Se è qui sulla terra, attraverserete molte angosce per proteggerlo e accrescerlo; ma se lo avrete in cielo, vivrete in pace e senza paura, accrescendolo ancora di più. Il Signore nella parabola ci invita a essere preparati per il momento in cui verrà a incontrarci, ad aprirgli la porta non appena arriverà; al suo arrivo, lo stesso padrone prenderà la sua tunica per metterli a tavola e servirli. Il


Signore ci servirà nel banchetto eterno, quando arriveremo accanto a Lui; anche se è meraviglioso che ora, da questo mondo, ci serva nella persona dei suoi sacerdoti, il suo stesso Corpo come cibo per il cammino in ogni Eucaristia. Per questo Gesù ci dice ogni domenica, popolo di Dio: alzatevi e mangiate, perché la strada è lunga!

XIX Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
“**Bienaventurados los esclavos a quienes su señor encuentre vigilantes cuando llegue**”
En el Evangelio de hoy, vemos a Jesús dirigiéndose a sus discípulos y a nosotros con mucha ternura: «*No tengan miedo, mi pequeño rebaño*» (Lc 12, 32). La razón para no temer es que el Padre ha considerado oportuno darnos el Reino. Un reino que comienza ahora, que estamos construyendo en la tierra sembrando amor, justicia, paz, reconciliación y verdad, tal como lo hemos hecho, y la alegría de pertenecer a él; aunque sabemos que el Reino en su plenitud solo estará después de este mundo que pasa. Por eso, el Señor Jesús nos exhorta a acumular un tesoro en el cielo, un tesoro que no se acaba, donde no llega el ladrón ni lo destruye la polilla. Jesús dice: «*Donde esté tu tesoro, allí estará tu corazón*» (Lc 12, 34). Entonces, ¿dónde está tu tesoro? Si está aquí en la tierra, pasarás por muchas angustias para protegerlo y acrecentarlo; pero si lo tienes en el cielo, vivirás en paz y sin temor, acrecentándolo aún más. El Señor en la parábola nos invita a estar preparados para cuando venga a nuestro encuentro, a abrirle la puerta en cuanto llegue; al llegar, el mismo maestro tomará su túnica para sentarlos a la mesa y servirles. El Señor nos servirá en el banquete eterno, cuando lleguemos junto a él; aunque es maravilloso que ahora, desde este mundo, nos sirva en la persona de sus sacerdotes, su propio Cuerpo como alimento para el camino en cada Eucaristía. Por eso Jesús nos dice cada domingo, pueblo de Dios: ¡levántate y come, porque el camino es largo!

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on week-end masses and the following week, must be requested by **Wednesday of each week at office closing time or 4:00pm**. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. **Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name**. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation. The following are required at St. Jude’s:

- ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- ♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for at least one year before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
