

First Communion & **Confirmation Program**

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

XIX Sunday in Ordinary Time

On this Sunday we continue listening to St. John's discourse on the Bread of Life. After feeding the multitudes with five barley loaves and two fish, Jesus begins to teach the deeper meaning of the miracle. Last Sunday, he invited us to look for food that does not perish. Jesus first responds to physical hunger and then to spiritual food, which lasts forever that is himself.

Today Jesus tells us that He is the bread that came down from heaven. This statement speaks about Jesus' purpose, a purpose for you and me: to bring us into a relationship with His Father. A Father whom only Jesus knows and who sends Him who is His Son. who offers Himself as food for believers.

My brothers and sisters on this Sunday and always, I invite you, that when you come to receive the Holy Communion, come full of faith, joy and gratitude to the Father who sent us His Son, Jesus Christ. God made man, who gave us His body and blood on the cross, and who continues to give it to us in every Eucharist, "The Eucharist is the sacrament of the presence of Christ, who gives himself to us because he loves us".

XIX Domenica del Tempo Ordinario

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one vear.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor. • Applicant must be actively involved in
- a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request. It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pas-
