

Confessions
The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program
Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony
Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's Parish are asked to contact the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

XXI Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Strive to enter through the narrow door”

There is a question that has always plagued believers: are there many or few who are saved? At certain times, this problem became so acute that it plunged some people into terrible anguish. This Sunday's Gospel tells us that one day this problem was put to Jesus: "As he was walking towards Jerusalem, someone said to him: 'Lord, will only a few be saved?' The question, as can be seen, is about the number, about how many are saved: many or few? Jesus, in his response, shifts the focus from how many are saved to how to be saved, that is, entering *"through the narrow gate."* Through this, Christ reminds us that the invitation to His feast is open to all. However, each person must struggle to be there. We must do what we must do by playing our roles well. This is the only way we can be guaranteed a place in the feast of the kingdom of God. At the end of the Gospel Jesus says, *“some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last”* God knows very well what is in our hearts, we cannot deceive him. That is why *"Live in truth, facing God, trying to please him in everything... The rest will be given to you in addition".*

XXI Domenica del Tempo Ordinario

“Sforzatevi di entrare per la porta stretta”

C'è una domanda che da sempre tormenta i credenti: sono molti o pochi coloro che si salvano? In certi momenti, questo problema è diventato così acuto da gettare alcune persone in una terribile angoscia. Il Vangelo di questa domenica ci racconta che un giorno questo problema fu posto a Gesù: "Mentre camminava verso Gerusalemme, un tale gli disse: *'Signore, sono pochi quelli che si salvano?'*" La domanda, come si può vedere, riguarda il numero, quanti sono salvati: molti o pochi? Gesù, nella sua risposta, sposta l'attenzione da quanti sono salvati a come essere salvati, cioè entrando *"per la porta stretta"*. Con questo, Cristo ci ricorda che l'invito al Suo banchetto è aperto a tutti. Tuttavia, ognuno deve lottare per esserci. Dobbiamo fare ciò che dobbiamo fare, interpretando bene i nostri ruoli. Solo così possiamo garantirci un posto al banchetto del regno di Dio. Alla fine del Vangelo, Gesù dice: *"Alcuni sono ultimi che saranno primi, e alcuni sono primi che saranno ultimi"*. Dio sa bene cosa c'è nei nostri cuori, non possiamo ingannarlo. Ecco perché *"Camminate nella verità, rivolti a Dio, cercando di piacergli in ogni cosa... Il resto vi sarà dato in più"*.


XXI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

“Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta que es

angosta”


Hay una pregunta que siempre ha atormentado a los creyentes: ¿son muchos o pocos los que serán salvados? En ciertos momentos, este problema se agudizó tanto que sumió a algunos en una terrible angustia. El Evangelio de este domingo nos cuenta que un día le plantearon este problema a Jesús: «Mientras caminaba hacia Jerusalén, alguien le dijo: “*Señor, ¿es verdad que son pocos los que se salvan?*”». La pregunta, como se puede ver, se centra en el número, en cuántos se salvan: ¿muchos o pocos? En su respuesta, Jesús cambia el enfoque de cuántos se salvan a cómo ser salvados, eso es, entrando *"por la puerta que es angosta"*. De esta manera, Cristo nos recuerda que la invitación a su banquete esta abierta a todos. Sin embargo, cada persona debe esforzarse por estar allí. Debemos hacer lo que tenemos que hacer, desempeñando bien nuestro papel. Solo así nos será garantizado un lugar en el banquete del reino de Dios. Al final del Evangelio, Jesús dice: *"Pues los que ahora son últimos, serán los primeros; y los que ahora son los primeros, serán los últimos"*. Dios conoce muy bien lo que hay en nuestros corazones; no podemos engañarlo. Por eso *"vivan en la verdad, de cara a Dios, procurando agradecerle en todo... Lo demás se les dará por añadidura"*.

Transitional Diaconate Ordinations

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week, must be requested by **Wednesday of each week at office closing time or 4:00pm**. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. **Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name**. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation. The following are required at St. Jude’s:

- ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- ♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year. requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a recommendation letter from your Pastor.
