



### **Sacrament of Baptism**

Contact the parish at least six months before the desired date of baptism to obtain information regarding requirements and sacramental preparation, and to discuss any other concerns you may have. Please consider starting the process during the pregnancy which will make the process easier.

### **Confessions**

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

## First Communion & **Confirmation Program**

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, in our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

## **Sacrament of Matrimony**

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

## Advent

The first sentence of any book must be interesting, engaging to invite the reader to continue reading.

St. Mark's Gospel is the first gospel of the four. Today we proclaim the first page of his gospel as written. A simple and solemn statement that continues to resonate throughout the world with the same strong power as the first day. "The beginning of the good news of Jesus Christ, the Son of God,". There is no manger, no shepherds, no angels, no heavenly music, no wise men, nothing. Yet, no matter how much we repeat this first phrase of Mark's gospel, we will never embrace it in its entirety.

This gospel does not announce the victory of a Roman emperor but the victorious presence of God who in Jesus Christ brings us the hope of

St. Mark seems to tell us: first things first, the first is the gospel and the gospel is Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

St. John the Baptist, a hinge that unites the old and the new, a light that goes out when the true Light arrives. The Baptist is the last prophet sent by God to present and introduce the one who comes.

His message is reduced to two verbs: prepare and repent.

Il Vangelo di San Marco è il primo dei quattro vangeli. Oggi proclamiamo la prima pagina del suo vangelo così come è scritta. Una dichiarazione semplice e solenne che continua a risuonare in tutto il mondo con la stessa forza forte del primo giorno. "L'inizio della buona novella di Gesù Cristo, il Figlio di **Dio**". Non c'è né mangiatoia, né pastori, né angeli, né musica celeste, né saggi, niente. Tuttavia, per quanto ripetiamo questa prima frase del vangelo di Marco, non la accoglieremo mai nella sua interezza.

Ouesto vangelo non annuncia la vittoria di un imperatore romano ma la presenza vittoriosa di Dio che in Gesù Cristo ci porta la speranza della salvezza.

San Marco sembra dirci: prima le cose, il primo è il vangelo e il vangelo è Gesù Cristo, il Figlio di Dio.

San Giovanni Battista, cerniera che unisce il vecchio e il nuovo, una luce che si spegne quando arriva la vera Luce. Il Battista è l'ultimo profeta inviato da Dio per presentare e introdurre colui che viene.

Il suo messaggio si riduce a due verbi: prepararsi e pentirsi.

La primera frase de cualquier libro debe ser interesante, atractiva para invitar al lector a continuar leyendo.

El Evangelio de San Marcos es el primero de los cuatro evangelios. Hoy proclamamos la primera página de su evangelio tal como está escrito. Una declaración sencilla y solemne que sigue resonando en todo el mundo con la misma fuerza que el primer día. "El comienzo de la buena nueva de Jesucristo, el Hijo de Dios". No hay pesebre, ni pastores, ni ángeles, ni música celestial, ni reyes magos, nada. Sin embargo, por mucho que repitamos esta primera frase del evangelio de Marcos, nunca la aceptaremos en su totalidad.

Este evangelio no anuncia la victoria de un emperador romano sino la presencia victoriosa de Dios que en Jesucristo nos trae la esperanza de la salvación.

San Marcos parece decirnos: lo primero es lo primero, lo primero es el evangelio y el evangelio es Jesucristo, el Hijo de Dios.

San Juan Bautista, bisagra que une lo viejo y lo nuevo, luz que se apaga cuando llega la Luz verdadera. El Bautista es el último profeta enviado por Dios para presentar e introducir al que viene.

Su mensaje se reduce a dos verbos: prepararse y arrepentirse.

## Planning to be a Catholic **School Teacher?**

It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor. It is highly recommended to contact the pastor a year in advance, especially in light of the fact that all universities make this matter known to every student at the beginning of the year. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes (at least 1 year before the application).
- Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for a minimum of 12 months prior to approaching the
- Make your request 3 months in advance. Applicant must be the one making the requests.
- No request by a relative or a parent will be accepted.

The pastor has to be able to recommend you, and that is only possible if he knows you at the basic level of regular mass attendance. Personal knowledge of the candidate's faith practice is what the pastor needs to recommend, not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.
