

III Sunday of Advent

Dear brothers and sisters, today we celebrate the Sunday of joy, of happiness called "Gaudete", it is the day on which the rose candle of the Advent wreath is lit. This color is a sign of the joy that our waiting brings us. The first reading from the prophet Isaiah begins in the way: "The wilderness and the dry land shall be glad; the desert shall rejoice and blossom; like the crocus it shall blossom abundantly and rejoice with joy and singing". And the ransomed of the Lord shall return, and come to Zion with singing; everlasting joy shall be upon their heads; they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away". This is the joy that Christmas brings, the Nativity of the Lord. It is like a woman who carries a child in her womb, no matter how many discomforts she suffers because of her pregnancy, she maintains joy because of the child she is expecting and after the delivery she rejoices to see her child.

On this third Sunday of Advent let us exalt the joy of being close to receiving the One who came from above, to the purest womb of the Holy Virgin and that we prepare to experience the second coming of Jesus Christ our Lord.

III Domenica Di Avvento
