Sacrament of Baptism

Contact the parish at least six months before the desired date of baptism to obtain information regarding requirements and sacramental preparation, and to discuss any other concerns you may have.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

III Sunday of Advent

"Shout for joy, O daughter of Zion." Rejoice in the Lord at all times.

Dear brothers and sisters, we have reached the third Sunday of Advent. This Sunday is called "gaudete," meaning "rejoice." When we wait for the fulfillment of a promise that will bring us happiness, like finishing college, getting married, being ordained a priest, or a mother waiting for her child to be born, we can get tired of waiting, but at the same time we are happy because we know that we have achieved our goals. That is why while waiting for Christmas we must be patient and rejoice that the Son of God is coming soon.

That is why today the Word of God invites us to rejoice as the First Reading says "Sing, O daughter of Zion, shout for joy, Israel, be glad and rejoice with all your heart, Jerusa*lem"* (Zeph 3:14). St. Paul also makes a similar invitation to us in the second reading, "Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I will say, Rejoice. Let your gentleness be known to everyone. The Lord is near".

On this third Sunday of Advent let us exalt the joy of being close to receiving the one who came from above, to the purest womb of the Holy Virgin and that we prepare to experience the second coming of Jesus Christ our Lord.

III Domenica Di Avvento

Cari fratelli e sorelle, siamo giunti alla terza domenica di Avvento. Questa domenica è chiamata "gaudete", che significa "rallegrati". Quando aspettiamo il compimento di una promessa che ci porterà felicità, come finire l'università, sposarci, essere ordinati sacerdoti o come una madre che aspetta la nascita del suo bambino, possiamo stancarci di aspettare, ma allo stesso tempo siamo felici perché sappiamo di aver raggiunto i nostri obiettivi. Ecco perché nell'attesa del Natale dobbiamo essere pazienti e rallegrarci che il Figlio di Dio verrà presto.

Ecco perché oggi la Parola di Dio ci invita a rallegrarci come dice la prima lettura "Gioisci, figlia di Sion, giubila, Israele, rallegrati e rallegrati con tutto il cuore, Gerusalemme" (Sof 3,14). Anche San Paolo ci rivolge un invito simile nella seconda lettura: "Rallegratevi sempre nel Signore: ve lo ripeto: rallegratevi. La vostra mitezza sia nota a tutti. Il Signore è vicino". In questa terza domenica di Avvento esaltiamo la gioia di essere vicini ad accogliere colui che è venuto dall'alto, nel grembo purissimo della Vergine Santa e di prepararci a vivere la seconda venuta di Gesù Cristo nostro Signore.

III Domingo de Adviento

"Grita de alegría, hija de Sión". Alegraos en el Señor en todo tiempo.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, hemos llegado al tercer domingo de Adviento. Este domingo se llama "gaudete", que significa "alegraos". Cuando esperamos el cumplimiento de una promesa que nos traerá felicidad, como terminar la universidad, casarnos, ser ordenados sacerdotes, o una madre que espera el nacimiento de su hijo, podemos cansarnos de esperar, pero al mismo tiempo estamos contentos porque sabemos que hemos alcanzado nuestras metas. Por eso, mientras esperamos la Navidad, debemos ser pacientes y alegrarnos de que el Hijo de Dios viene pronto.

Por eso, hoy la Palabra de Dios nos invita a alegrarnos como dice la Primera Lectura: "Canta, hija de Sión, grita de alegría, Israel; alégrate v regocíjate de todo corazón. Jerusalén" (Sof 3,14). También San Pablo nos hace una invitación similar en la segunda lectura: "Alegraos siempre en el Señor; os repito: ¡Alegraos!". "Que vuestra dulzura sea conocida por todos. El Señor está cerca". En este tercer domingo de Adviento exaltamos la alegría de estar cerca de recibir a aquel que vino de lo alto, al seno purísimo de la Santísima Virgen y que nos preparemos para vivir la segunda venida de Jesucristo nuestro Señor.



- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
