The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & **Confirmation Program**

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.



VII Sunday in Ordinary Time

My dear brothers and sisters, the readings for this Sunday speak to us about mercy and love for our enemies.

In his teaching, Jesus does not set limits on mercy, because he commands us to love our enemies, all of them, whoever they may be. He tells us three things that we must do for those who hate us or do us wrong: do good to them, bless them, and pray for them.

Turning the other cheek to those who have hit us must mean truly forgiving, even if this implies the possibility that they will hit us again. I believe that this is not exactly seeking our own harm but rather knowing how to give a new opportunity. As for whether someone takes our cloak then we must also give him our tunic, I believe that it means helping the thief who we see in real need so that he does not steal again.

Every human being is capable of loving, that is in our nature, the capacity to love and to be loved; but faith implies the conviction that every human being is a child of God and deserves our love, forgiveness, and help. Even the greatest criminals have someone to love and who loves them. Jesus says: "Even sinners love those who love them... Let us ask the Lord to give us the ability to love and forgive in the same way He loves and forgives us.

VII Domenica del Tempo Ordinario

Miei cari fratelli e sorelle, le letture di questa domenica ci parlano di misericordia e amore per i nostri nemici.

Nel suo insegnamento, Gesù non pone limiti alla misericordia, perché ci comanda di amare i nostri nemici, tutti quanti, chiunque essi siano. Ci dice tre cose che dobbiamo fare per coloro che ci odiano o ci fanno del male: fare loro del bene, benedirli e pregare

Porgere l'altra guancia a coloro che ci hanno colpito deve significare perdonare veramente, anche se ciò implica la possibilità che ci colpiscano di nuovo. Credo che questo non significhi esattamente cercare il nostro male, ma piuttosto sapere come dare una nuova opportunità. Quanto al fatto che qualcuno ci tolga il mantello, allora dobbiamo anche dargli la tunica, credo che significhi aiutare il ladro che vediamo in reale bisogno affinché non rubi di nuovo.

Ogni essere umano è capace di amare, questa è nella nostra natura, la capacità di amare ed essere amati; ma la fede implica la convinzione che ogni essere umano è figlio di Dio e merita il nostro amore, perdono e

aiuto. Anche i più grandi criminali hanno qualcuno da amare e che li ama. Gesù dice: "Anche i peccatori amano coloro che li amano... Ĉhiediamo al Signore di darci la capacità di amare e perdonare nello stesso modo in cui Lui ama e perdona noi.

VII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, las lecturas de este domingo nos hablan de la misericordia y del amor a los enemigos.

Poner la otra mejilla a quien nos ha golpeado debe significar perdonar verdaderamente, aunque esto implique la posibilidad de que nos golpeen de nuevo. Creo que esto no es precisamente buscar nuestro propio mal sino saber dar una nueva oportunidad. En cuanto a si alguien nos quita el manto entonces debemos darle también la túnica, creo que se trata de ayudar al ladrón que vemos realmente necesitado para que no vuelva a robar.

Todo ser humano es capaz de amar, es decir, está en nuestra naturaleza la capacidad de amar y de ser amado; pero la fe implica la convicción de que todo ser humano es hijo de Dios y merece nuestro amor, perdón y ayuda. Incluso los mayores criminales tienen a alguien a quien amar y que los ama. Jesús dice: "También los pecadores aman a quienes los aman... Pidamos al Señor que nos dé la capacidad de amar y perdonar de la misma manera que Él nos ama y nos perdona.

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor. • Applicant must be actively involved in

- Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your re-
