First Communion & **Confirmation Program**

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.



V Sunday in Ordinary Time

The call. In today's gospel according to St. Luke, we find the call that Jesus makes to the first three disciples, who will be his witnesses in such significant moments of his ministry, such as the resurrection of a girl, the transfiguration on Mount Tabor and the prayer in the Garden of Olives. They are Peter, James and John.

The three were washing their nets together with their other fellow fishermen, after an unsuccessful night of fishing, when Jesus asks them permission to board Simon's boat and move it a little away from the shore, so that from there he can speak to the crowd gathered around him. Jesus, who as God is all-powerful, as a human needs help to fulfill his mission and asks for the necessary support. Let us not close ourselves off from asking for help with humility, because we all need everyone.

Those fishermen grant Jesus what he asks. After preaching Jesus orders them to put the boat out into the deep and cast their nets again. Simon Peter speaks on behalf of everyone, agreeing to what Jesus asked, but not before warning him that they had already worked all night and had caught nothing. Although he does not say it, he knows in advance that if there was no fishing at night, there will be none during the day either, but there was such strength and depth in Jesus' preaching that they obey him and that is why Simon Peter adds: "But, trusting in your word, I will cast the nets" (Lk 5:5). We already know that the result was a miraculous catch.

My brothers and sisters, the disciples trust in the Lord Jesus, so let us trust in the same way that whatever work we do (including studies and housework) let us do in the name of the one who can do everything the Lord Jesus Christ.

V Domenica del Tempo Ordinario

La chiamata. le reti. Simon Pietro parla a nome di tutti, acconsentendo a ciò che Gesù aveva chiesto, ma non prima di averlo avvisato che avevano già lavorato tutta la notte e non avevano pescato nulla. Sebbene non lo dica, sa in anticipo che se non c'è stata pesca di notte, non ci sarà nemmeno durante il giorno, ma c'era tale forza e profondità nella predicazione di Gesù che gli obbediscono ed è per questo che Simon Pietro aggiunge: "Ma, fiducioso nella tua parola, getterò le reti" (Lc 5:5). Sappiamo già che il risultato è stata una pesca miracolosa.

Fratelli miei, i discepoli confidano nel Signore Gesù, quindi confidiamo allo stesso modo che qualsiasi lavoro facciamo (compresi gli studi e le faccende domestiche) facciamolo nel nome di colui che può fare tutto il Signore Gesù Cristo.

V Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

La llamada. En el evangelio de hoy según san Lucas encontramos la llamada que Jesús hace a los tres primeros discípulos, que serán sus testigos en momentos significativos de su ministerio, como la resurrección de una niña, la transfiguración en el monte Tabor y la oración en el Huerto de los Olivos. Se trata de Pedro, Santiago y Juan. Los tres estaban lavando las redes junto con sus otros compañeros pescadores, después de una noche de pesca infructuosa, cuando Jesús les pide permiso para subir a la barca de Simón, la aleja un poco de la orilla y desde allí habla a la multitud reunida a su alrededor. Jesús, que como Dios es todopoderoso, como hombre necesita ayuda para cumplir su misión y pide el apoyo necesario. No nos cerremos a pedir ayuda con humildad, porque todos necesitamos de todos.

Aquellos pescadores le conceden a Jesús lo que les pide. Después de predicar, Jesús les ordena que echen la barca mar adentro y echen de nuevo las redes. Simón Pedro habla en nombre de todos, accediendo a lo que Jesús pedía, no sin antes advertirle que ya habían trabajado toda la noche y no habían pescado nada. Aunque no lo dice, sabe de antemano que si no había pesca de noche, tampoco la habrá de día, pero había tanta fuerza y profundidad en la predicación de Jesús que le obedecen y por eso Simón Pedro añade: "Pero yo, confiando en tu palabra, echaré las redes" (Lc 5,5). Ya sabemos que el resultado fue una pesca milagrosa.

Hermanos míos, los discípulos confian en el Señor Jesús, así que confiemos de la misma manera que cualquier trabajo que hagamos (incluso los estudios y las tareas del hogar) hagámoslo en nombre de aquel que todo lo puede el Señor Jesucristo.



Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name. Thank you for your understanding and your cooperation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one vear.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year. Please ensure that you meet these re-
- quirements before making your request. It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
