

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

# First Communion & **Confirmation Program**

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, in our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

# **Sacrament of Matrimony**

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

### **VI Sunday in Ordinary Time**



My brothers and sisters, this coming Wednesday February 14, we begin the season of Lent. We begin Lent with imposition of ashes. Let's make a great beginning of Lent 2024 by attending the Holy Mass. We need Lent. We need cleansing and healing. We need Jesus.

Last Sunday we saw Jesus' first miracle of healing a fever to whom? To Simon's mother-in-law. Jesus goes to her, takes her hand, and lifts her up and then she begins to serve - with thankfulness.

This Sunday we see another healing miracle of Jesus, the healing of a leper. The first reading describes very well the leprosy: It begins with a small blotch and then little by little consumes a person outside and inside.

We know that in Jesus' time every person with leprosy was expelled from society. But Jesus looked with compassion at the leper, touched him, and said to him: "I do choose. Be made clean". Jesus touched the untouchable and taught us that we can all be touched by the love of God, and we can be cleansed and healed. For God there are no lepers.

# VI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

# Planning to be a Catholic **School Teacher?**

It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor. It is highly recommended to contact the pastor a year in advance, especially in light of the fact that all universities make this matter known to every student at the beginning of the year. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submit-

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes (at least 1 year before the application).
- Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for a minimum of 12 months prior to approaching the pastor. Make your request 3 months in advance.
- Applicant must be the one making the requests.
- No request by a relative or a parent will be accepted.

The pastor has to be able to recommend you, and that is only possible if he knows you at the basic level of regular mass attendance. Personal knowledge of the candidate's faith practice is what the pastor needs to recommend, not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.
