Sacrament of Baptism

First Communion & Confirmation Program

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

I Sunday of Lent Dear brothers and sisters, we begin the Lenten season, a time of preparation for the events of the Paschal Triduum: passion, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We begin the path that leads us to Easter. How do we start? By acknowledging ourselves as sinners. The ashes we received on our heads on Wednesday is a confession of humility: confession of repentance: confession that we know who we are and who God is; confession of readiness to go towards Easter determined to a new life. For that, we know that we need the Grace of God that is achieved through prayer, fasting, almsgiving, but also and above all, with the Word of God that gives meaning to these Lenten practices. With the Word of God, we listen to Him, who speaks to us and tells us what we must do, beyond the Lenten practices. The Word of God calls us to "open our door" so that God the Lord can enter first, and then together with Him, all our brothers and sisters as our holy Father Pope Francis said.

We are called, then, to "open the door of our *heart"*, and that the Lenten practices are above all a personal help to strengthen our spirit in the fulfillment of divine mandates and in the availability to open ourselves with love. Have a blessed Lent.

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week must be requested by Wednesday of each week. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Thank you for your understanding and your cooperation.

Planning to be a Catholic School Teacher?

It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor. It is highly recommended to contact the pastor a year in advance, especially in light of the fact that all universities make this matter known to every student at the beginning of the year. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted.

- The following are required at St. Jude's:
- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes (at least 1 year before the application).
- Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for a minimum of 12 months prior to approaching the pastor.
- Make your request 3 months in advance. Applicant must be the one making the requests.
- No request by a relative or a parent will be accepted.

The pastor has to be able to recommend you, and that is only possible if he knows you at the basic level of regular mass attendance. Personal knowledge of the candidate's faith practice is what the pastor needs to recommend, not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.
