Sacrament of Baptism

First Communion & Confirmation Program

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

The Presentation of the Lord

Dear brothers and sisters, today we celebrate the feast of the presentation of the baby Jesus in the temple or as it is also known, the Candlemass. This is a feast that has been celebrated for more than 1.500 years, more than 15 centuries that this solemnity has been celebrated. This celebration is a feast where we remember how the Virgin Mary and Saint Joseph take the 40-day-old Baby Jesus to the temple in Jerusalem. It has been 40 days since we celebrated Christmas and today, we celebrate his presentation in the temple.

Saint Joseph and the Virgin Mary were very respectful of God's law that said that the firstborn should be taken to be presented at the temple. That day was also the purification of the mother; the Purification of the Virgin Mary and at the same time the Presentation of the Baby Jesus, of consecrating him to God, of offering him to God. Why is it called the Candlemass? It is because people make processions carrying candles with them to light their way during the procession. These candles also represent the light of Christ and call us to be light in the darkness, to guide and be guided, to celebrate the richness of our cultural and spiritual traditions.

My dear brothers and sisters I invite you to present ourselves to God, to dedicate ourselves completely to Jesus Christ, following him in love and seeking to do his will.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend vou, he needs to know vou. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.
