

Contact the parish at least six months before the desired date of baptism to obtain information regarding requirements and sacramental preparation, and to discuss any other concerns you may have. Please consider starting the process during the pregnancy which will make the process easier.

Confessions

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & **Confirmation Program**

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, in our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

V Sunday in Ordinary Time "The Lord heals broken hearts and binds up their wounds."

My brothers and sisters the readings of this Sunday speak about illnesses and how the Lord heals them. In the Old Testament, illness was something difficult to understand. People believed that illness, like poverty and other misfortunes, were punishments that God sent for their own sins; and when someone believed he was free of guilt, then he thought that he purged the sins left by his ancestors. That is why, in the first reading Job expresses the mentality described above. Job found no reason for his illness and all his misfortunes, being as he was, a faithful and generous Jew with those in need. In the gospel we see how Jesus begins the day in the synagogue, the place of worship of the highest God. There Jesus TEACHES and amazes those gathered because he teaches with authority and casts out the evil spirits that nest in the hearts of men. After the celebration in the synagogue, Jesus goes to Peter's house. In the house are Peter's wife and his mother-in-law who has a high fever. At once someone tells Jesus about the illness of Peter's mother-in-law to whom he approaches tenderly, takes her hands, lifts her up, and right away the fever disappears, then the service begins. The celebration began with a small miracle. The mother-in-law, without a name, served the entire family and became a disciple of Jesus." That same day at sunset, many sick people and some possessed by demons were brought to Jesus whom he cured. After that busy day, Jesus got up early in the morning

and went to pray. Are you suffering from any illness? I invite you to come to Jesus, to seek forgiveness, the remedy of your suffering and to be children of

Le persone credevano che la malattia, come la povertà e altre disgrazie, fossero punizioni inviate da Dio per i propri peccati; e quando qualcuno si credeva esente da colpa, allora pensava di aver purificato i peccati lasciati dai suoi antenati. Ecco perché nella prima lettura Giobbe esprime la mentalità sopra descritta. Giobbe non trovò motivo per la sua malattia e per tutte le sue disgrazie, essendo com'era un ebreo fedele e generoso con i bisognosi. Nel vangelo vediamo come Gesù inizia la giornata nella sinagoga, luogo di culto del Dio

altissimo. Lì Gesù INSEGNA e stupisce i riuniti perché insegna con autorità e scaccia gli spiriti maligni che si annidano nel cuore degli uomini. Dopo la celebrazione nella sinagoga, Gesù si reca a casa di Pietro. Nella casa ci sono la moglie di Pietro e la suocera che ha la febbre alta. Subito qualcuno racconta a Gesù della malattia della suocera di Pietro alla quale egli si avvicina teneramente, le prende le mani, la solleva, e subito la febbre scompare, poi comincia il servizio. La celebrazione è iniziata con un piccolo miracolo. La suocera, senza nome, servì tutta la famiglia e divenne discepola di Gesù". Quello stesso giorno, al tramonto, furono portati a Gesù molti malati e alcuni posseduti dai demoni, che egli guarì. Dopo quella giornata impegnativa, Gesù si alzò presto la mattina e andò a pregare.

Soffri di qualche malattia? Vi invito a venire a Gesù, a cercare il perdono, il rimedio alla vostra sofferenza e ad essere figli di Dio.

V Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

"El Señor sana a los quebrantados de corazón v venda sus heridas".

Hermanos y hermanas, las lecturas de este domingo hablan de las enfermedades y de cómo el Señor las sana. En el Antiguo Testamento la enfermedad era algo dificil de entender. La gente creía que la enfermedad, como la pobreza y otras desgracias, eran castigos enviados por Dios por sus pecados; y cuando alguien se creía libre de culpa, entonces creía haber purificado los pecados dejados por sus antepasados. Por eso en la primera lectura Job expresa la mentalidad descrita anteriormente. Job no encontró motivo para su enfermedad y todas sus desgracias, siendo como era un judío fiel y generoso con los necesitados. En el evangelio vemos cómo Jesús comienza el día en la sinagoga, lugar de adoración del Dios Altísimo. Allí Jesús ENSEÑA y asombra a los reunidos porque enseña con autoridad y ahuyenta los espíritus malignos que acechan en el corazón de los hombres. Después de la celebración en la sinagoga, Jesús se dirige a casa de Pedro, allí están la esposa de Pedro y su suegra que tiene fiebre alta. Inmediatamente alguien le cuenta a Jesús sobre la enfermedad de la suegra de Pedro. Jesús se le acerca y tomándola de las manos tiernamente, la levanta, e inmediatamente la fiebre desaparece, luego comienza el servicio. La celebración comenzó con un pequeño milagro. La suegra, sin nombre, sirvió a toda la familia y se hizo discípula de Jesús". Ese mismo día, al ponerse el sol, fueron llevados a Jesús muchos enfermos y algunos endemoniados, a quien sanó. Después de ese día ajetreado, Jesús se levantó temprano en la mañana y fue a orar. ¿Sufres de alguna enfermedad? Los invito a venir a Jesús, a buscar el perdón, el remedio a su sufrimiento y a ser hijos de Dios.



Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week must be requested by Wednesday of each week. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Planning to be a Catholic **School Teacher?**

It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor. It is highly recommended to contact the pastor a year in advance, especially in light of the fact that all universities make this matter known to every student at the beginning of the year. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes (at least 1 year before the application).
- Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for a minimum of 12 months prior to approaching the pastor.
- Make your request 3 months in advance. Applicant must be the one making the requests.
- No request by a relative or a parent will be accepted.

The pastor has to be able to recommend you, and that is only possible if he knows you at the basic level of regular mass attendance. Personal knowledge of the candidate's faith practice is what the pastor needs to recommend, not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.
