II Sunday in Ordinary Time

My brothers and sisters, we begin the Ordinary Time, the public life of Jesus, of his miracles, healings, and forgiveness of sins. We begin the public life of Jesus with the wedding at Cana, which is the symbol of every marriage. The wedding at Cana symbolizes the covenant of love between Christ the Bridegroom and the Church, his beloved bride.

This miracle is also the beginning of the building of the Church, because thanks to this miracle "his disciples believed in him" (Jn 2:11). Therefore, those who were destined to be pillars of the Church were strengthened for their mission from the beginning.

At the beginning of the public life of Jesus, the role of the Virgin Mary is very important in the realization of this miracle, because it is she who raises the problem of the bride and groom to her Son Jesus, telling him: "They have no wine" (Jn 2:3b). Jesus seems to resist his mother's invitation to enter his "hour," but how can one resist a Mother? Do what he tells you. This invitation to do what "he tells you" is also for you and me.

Let us ask the Virgin Mary to always help us do what Jesus tells us, and may Jesus transform our lives in the same way that he transformed water into wine.

II Domenica Del Tempo Ordinario


