XV Sunday in Ordinary Time This Sunday Saint Paul in his Letter to the Ephesians tells us that you and I are chosen by God our Lord, before all ages. God chose us for a purpose, so that we would be holy and blameless before Him through love. God has not chosen us for Christian mediocrity, to simply avoid evil, but he chose us for holiness, that is what we were baptized for. If we believe and take this choice seriously, we have many challenges ahead of us to face, to always seek spiritual growth, since those who are not seeking it are already falling into conformity and mediocrity.

Young people who are now making important and transcendent decisions for their lives will do so with more joy, peace and security as they know they have been chosen by God and will behave accordingly.

The prophet Amos tells us in today's first reading that he was not a prophet, nor the son of a prophet, but rather a shepherd. Regardless of this, the Lord called him from behind the flock and told him: "Go and prophesy" (Am 7, 12-15). Just as God called Amos, this is how the Lord is calling you and fearlessly sends you to evangelize, in your family, school or work. "Go and prophesv"

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week, must be requested by Wednesday of each week. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for a minimum of one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
