

XVII Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's first reading, our father Abraham leaves us a great example of insistent and intercession prayer. Whoever intercedes for others in his/her prayer is loving them when praying. Everyone prays for his/her loved ones, family and friends, but not everyone prays for strangers. Anyone feels moved to pray for good people, but getting to pray for those who have had a bad conduct presents the most perfect prayer in love; praying like this or praying for our enemies sanctifies us even more.

In today's Gospel the disciples ask Jesus: "Teach us to pray, as John taught his disciples" Prayer is one of the thematic lines of St Luke. In this passage, the disciples make this plea to Jesus when he returns from his prayer.

Often, several times a day, Jesus withdrew to pray, bursting into prayer to the Father in front of those who listened to him. That is why the disciples want to learn to pray from Jesus. It was then that Jesus taught his disciples the Our Father, the most beautiful prayer.

On this Sunday Jesus invites us, his disciples, to be insistent and persevering in prayer. Not because by insisting we are going to change God's will, but because by praying we are going to strengthen our will to accept the Lord's will, just as by persevering we are going to grow in our affiliation.

Nel Vangelo di oggi i discepoli chiedono a Gesù: "Insegnaci a pregare, come Giovanni ha insegnato ai suoi discepoli". La preghiera è uno dei temi centrali di San Luca. In questo brano, i discepoli rivolgono questa supplica a Gesù quando torna dalla sua preghiera.

Spesso, più volte al giorno, Gesù si ritirava a pregare, prorompendo in una preghiera al Padre davanti a coloro che lo ascoltavano. Ecco perché i discepoli vogliono imparare a pregare da Gesù. Fu allora che Gesù insegnò ai suoi discepoli il Padre Nostro, la preghiera più bella. In questa domenica, Gesù invita noi suoi discepoli a essere insistenti e perseveranti nella preghiera; non perché insistendo cambieremo la volontà di Dio, ma perché pregando rafforzeremo la nostra volontà di accettare la volontà del Signore, così come perseverando cresceremo nella nostra appartenenza.

XVII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

En la primera lectura de hoy, nuestro padre Abraham nos deja un gran ejemplo de oración insistente e intercesora. Quien intercede por los demás en su oración, los ama al orar. Todos oran por sus seres queridos, familiares y amigos, pero no todos oran por desconocidos. Cualquiera se siente impulsado a orar por las personas buenas, pero orar por quienes han tenido una mala conducta representa la oración más perfecta en el amor; orar así, o por nuestros enemigos, nos santifica aún más.

En el Evangelio de hoy, los discípulos le piden a Jesús: «Enséñanos a orar, como Juan enseñó a sus discípulos». La oración es uno de los temas de San Lucas. En este pasaje, los discípulos le hacen esta súplica a Jesús al regresar de su oración.

Muy a menudo, varias veces al día, Jesús se retiraba a orar, prorrumpiendo en oración al Padre delante de quienes lo escuchaban. Por eso, los discípulos quieren aprender a orar con Jesús. Fue entonces cuando Jesús enseñó a sus discípulos el Padrenuestro, la oración más hermosa.

En este domingo Jesús nos invita a nosotros, sus discípulos, a ser insistentes y perseverantes en la oración. No porque insistiendo vamos a cambiar la voluntad de Dios, sino porque orando vamos a fortalecer nuestra voluntad para aceptar la voluntad del Señor, así como perseverando vamos a crecer en nuestra afiliación.

Mass Intentions

We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year. requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
