XIII Sunday in Ordinary Time The readings of this Sunday speak about sick and healing, life and death. The First Reading from the Book of Wisdom tells us that "God did not make death ... For God formed man to be imperishable, the image of his own nature he made him." Psalm 30 expresses the same sense, which says: "You, Lord, raised me up, O Lord, you brought up my soul from Sheol, restored me to life from among those gone down to the Pit" in another words "You, Lord, saved me from death and revived me when I was about to *die.*" That is why when we have a loved one in serious condition, we always believe that God can heal him, naturally or supernaturally, since it is always his hand that grants recovery.

The gospel tells us the situation of the girl who is at the point of death and of the woman who is suffering from hemorrhage for twelve years. This Gospel is the story of the healing and resurrection power that Jesus had. St. Mark tells us about the divine power of Jesus to heal and restore life. Jesus is the doctor of the doctors for that reason I invite you my brothers and sisters, to Come to the Lord as we are and be healed by the compassion of Jesus our healer. God loves each of us as if we were the only person on earth.

XIII Domenica Del Tempo Ordinario

Le letture di questa domenica parlano di malato e di guarigione, di vita e di morte. La prima lettura del Libro della Sapienza ci dice che «Dio non ha creato la morte... Dio infatti ha formato l'uomo perché fosse incorruttibile, lo ha creato a immagine della sua propria natura». Nello stesso senso esprime il Salmo 30, che dice: «Tu, Signore, *mi hai risuscitato, Signore, hai fatto risalire* l'anima mia dagli inferi, mi hai risuscitato da coloro che erano scesi nella fossa» in altre parole: «Tu, Signore, mi ha salvato dalla morte e mi ha rianimato quando stavo per morire". Ecco perché quando abbiamo una persona cara in gravi condizioni, crediamo sempre che Dio possa guarirla, in modo naturale o soprannaturale, poiché è sempre la sua mano a garantire la guarigione. Il vangelo ci racconta la situazione della ragazza che è in punto di morte e della donna che soffre di emorragia da dodici anni. Questo Vangelo è la storia del potere di guarigione e di risurrezione che Gesù aveva. San Marco ci parla del potere divino di Gesù di guarire e ridare la vita. Gesù è il dottore dei dottori per questo motivo vi invito, fratelli e sorelle, a venire al Signore così

come siamo e ad essere guariti dalla compassione di Gesù, il nostro guaritore. Dio ama ognuno di noi come se fossimo l'unica persona sulla terra.

XIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Las lecturas de este domingo hablan de enfermedad y curación, de vida y muerte. La Primera Lectura del Libro de la Sabiduría nos dice que "Dios no hizo la muerte... Porque Dios formó al hombre para que fuera imperecedero, lo hizo a imagen de su propia naturaleza". El Salmo 30 expresa el mismo significado, dice: "Tú, Señor, me levantaste, oh, Señor, sacaste mi alma del Seol, me devolviste la vida de entre los que descendieron al abismo" en otras palabras "El, Señor, me salvó de la muerte v me revivió cuando estaba a punto de morir". Por eso cuando tenemos un ser querido en estado grave, siempre creemos que Dios puede sanarlo, de forma natural o sobrenatural, ya que siempre es su mano la que otorga la recuperación.

El evangelio nos cuenta la situación de la niña que está a punto de morir y de la mujer que sufre una hemorragia desde hace doce años. Este Evangelio es la historia del poder de sanación y resurrección que tuvo Jesús. San Marcos nos habla del poder divino de Jesús para sanar y restaurar la vida. Jesús es el médico de los doctores por eso los invito mis hermanos y hermanas, a venir al Señor tal como somos y ser sanados por la compasión de Jesús nuestro sanador. Dios nos ama a cada uno de nosotros como si fuéramos la única persona en la tierra.

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week, must be requested by Wednesday of each week. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for a minimum of one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
