Sacrament of Baptism

Contact the parish at least six months before the desired date of baptism to obtain information regarding requirements and sacramental preparation, and to discuss any other concerns you may have.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, in our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

X Sunday in Ordinary Time My brothers and sisters, this Sunday the Word

of God presents us with the way of how the devil acts since the times of our first parents, Adam and Eve. The book of Genesis tells us the situation of our first parents, after they ate the fruit of the forbidden tree. The man and the woman hide from God, because they have realized their nakedness, and this makes them ashamed. The nakedness in this passage is a symbol of the grace of God that has been lost, because before they sinned, they were clothed in the grace of the Lord. This nakedness due to sin makes human beings feel unworthy of God, ashamed to appear before Him for having lost their innocence, by losing the friendship of God.

When God asks the man why he ate from the forbidden tree, he blames the woman, who offered him food; and then the woman explains her sin by saying that the serpent deceived her. Neither of them accepts their responsibility. The first step to defeating evil is to accept our guilt. God who loves us so much and does not want the death of the sinner, sent us his Son Jesus. Jesus is the conqueror of the devil. He came to restore what had been lost and to give us back the dignity that we had lost through sin. My brothers and sisters, let us ask Jesus our savior to protect us from the evil one and not allow us to fall into temptation.

X Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Mis hermanos y hermanas, este domingo la Palabra de Dios nos habla de la forma en que ha actuado el diablo desde los tiempos de nuestros primeros padres, Adán y Eva. El libro del Génesis nos cuenta la situación de nuestros primeros padres, después de que comieron del fruto del árbol prohibido. El hombre y la mujer se esconden de Dios, porque han tomado conciencia de su desnudez, y esto les avergüenza. La desnudez en este pasaje es un símbolo de la gracia de Dios que se ha perdido, porque antes de pecar fueron revestidos de la gracia del Señor. Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

- The following are required at St. Jude's:
- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one vear.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for a minimum of one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
