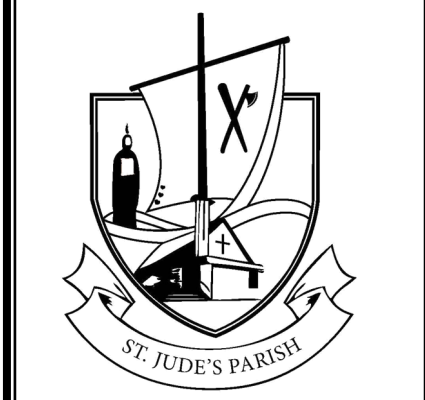

Sacrament of Baptism

Contact the parish at least six months before the desired date of baptism to obtain information regarding requirements and sacramental preparation, and to discuss any other concerns you may have. Please consider starting the process during the pregnancy which will make the process easier.

Confessions

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, in our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

Funerals

Please contact the Funeral Home of your choice first. They will contact the parish office to make church arrangements. Remember Catholic Cemeteries when making your arrangements.

V Sunday of Lent

“Now my soul is troubled. And what should I say — ‘Father, save me from this hour’?”
 Dear brothers and sisters, we are in the 5th Sunday of Lent, two Sundays before Easter. Today we have heard in the gospel of St. John Jesus Christ, God incarnate as a true man, a man who grew up in a family integrated with Mary and Joseph. We heard Jesus confessing that he is afraid of his coming death on the cross. Jesus courageously confesses publicly his fear before his apostles with great humility *“Now that I am afraid, am I going to say to my Father: ‘Father, deliver me from this hour’? No, for precisely for that hour I have come”* (Jn 12, 27).

Jesus, as a true man, feels fear before the Hour that is coming, and only asks one thing: *“Father, give glory to your name”* (Jn 12, 28). May this always be our first prayer and our first intention in everything we do. Then the voice of the Father was heard saying: *“I have glorified him, and I will glorify him again”* (Jn 12:28). If we do not glorify God, in any case, God is eternally glorified, but it is our call to participate in that glorification. For Jesus the hour of the cross has come, while for the Church the hour comes to begin to live and to be born *“Catholic”*, that is, with the universal mission of preaching the Good News at Pentecost. With today's Psalm 50, let us ask the Lord to create in us a new heart and a new spirit to fulfill his commandments. Also, with the prayer of the holy Rosary in each Hail Mary, let us ask the Mother of God and our Mother to pray for us now and at the hour of our death. *Amen.*

V Domenica Di Quaresima

“Ora la mia anima è turbata. E cosa dovrei dire: “Padre, salvami da quest’ora”?”
 Cari fratelli e sorelle, siamo nella V domenica di Quaresima, due domeniche prima di Pasqua. Oggi abbiamo ascoltato nel vangelo di San Giovanni. Gesù Cristo, Dio incarnato come vero uomo, un uomo cresciuto in una famiglia integrata con Maria e Giuseppe. Abbiamo sentito Gesù confessare che ha paura della sua imminente morte sulla croce. Gesù coraggiosamente confessa pubblicamente il suo timore davanti ai suoi apostoli con grande umiltà *«Ora che ho paura, dirò al Padre mio: ‘Padre, liberami da quest’ora’? No, perché proprio per quell’ora sono venuto»* (Gv 12,27). Gesù, da vero uomo, prova timore di fronte all’Ora che viene, e chiede solo una cosa: *“Padre, dà gloria al tuo nome”* (Gv 12,28). Possa questa essere sempre la nostra prima

preghiera e la nostra prima intenzione in tutto ciò che facciamo. Allora si udì la voce del Padre che diceva: *«L’ho glorificato e ancora lo glorificherò»* (Gv 12,28). Se non glorifichiamo Dio, in ogni caso, Dio è eternamente glorificato, ma è nostra chiamata a partecipare a quella glorificazione. Per Gesù è giunta l’ora della croce, mentre per la Chiesa giunge l’ora di cominciare a vivere e a nascere *“cattolici”*, cioè con la missione universale di predicare la Buona Novella a Pentecoste. Con il Salmo 50 di oggi chiediamo al Signore di creare in noi un cuore nuovo e uno spirito nuovo per compiere i suoi comandamenti. Inoltre, con la preghiera del santo Rosario in ogni Ave Maria, chiediamo alla Madre di Dio e Madre nostra di pregare per noi adesso e nell’ora della nostra morte. *Amen.*

V Domingo de Cuaresma


“Ahora que tengo miedo, le voy a decir a mi Padre: “Padre, librame de esta hora”?”
 Queridos hermanos y hermanas, estamos en el quinto domingo de Cuaresma, dos domingos antes de Pascua. Hoy escuchamos en el Evangelio de San Juan, Jesucristo, Dios encarnado como verdadero hombre, un hombre criado en familia integrada con María y José. Escuchamos a Jesús confesar que tiene miedo de su muerte inminente en la cruz. Jesús confiesa públicamente con valentía su miedo ante sus apóstoles con gran humildad *«Ahora que tengo miedo, ¿diré a mi Padre: ‘Padre, ¿librame de esta hora’? No, porque precisamente para esa hora he venido”* (Jn 12,27). Jesús, como verdadero hombre, siente miedo ante la Hora que llega y sólo pide una cosa: *“Padre, dale gloria a tu nombre”* (Jn 12,28). Que ésta sea siempre nuestra primera oración e intención en todo lo que hagamos. Entonces se escuchó la voz del Padre que decía: *“Lo he glorificado y volveré a glorificarlo”* (Jn 12,28). Si no glorificamos a Dios, en cualquier caso, Dios es eternamente glorificado, pero es nuestro llamado a participar de esa glorificación. Para Jesús ha llegado la hora de la cruz, mientras que para la Iglesia ha llegado la hora de empezar a vivir y nacer *“católica”*, es decir, con la misión universal de predicar la Buena Nueva en Pentecostés. Con el Salmo 50 de hoy le pedimos al Señor que cree en nosotros un corazón y un espíritu nuevos para cumplir sus mandamientos. Además, con el rezo del Santo Rosario en cada Ave María, pedimos a la Madre de Dios y Madre nuestra que ruegue por nosotros ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte. *Amén.*

 Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week must be requested by **Wednesday of each week**. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Thank you for your understanding and your cooperation.

Planning to be a Catholic School Teacher?
 It is critical for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor. It is highly recommended to contact the pastor a year in advance, especially in light of the fact that all universities make this matter known to every student at the beginning of the year. Please plan to have a conversation with your pastor early you will avoid disappointment and stress at the time when applications are to be submitted. The following are required at St. Jude’s:
 ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes (at least 1 year before the application).
 ♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for a minimum of 12 months prior to approaching the pastor.
 ♦ Make your request 3 months in advance. Applicant must be the one making the

requests.
 ♦ No request by a relative or a parent will be accepted.
 The pastor has to be able to recommend you, and that is only possible if he knows you at the basic level of regular mass attendance. Personal knowledge of the candidate’s faith practice is what the pastor needs to recommend, not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.
