

IV Sunday of Easter

My dear brothers and sisters, today on this Fourth Sunday of Easter, we celebrate the Feast of the Good Shepherd. In a brief Gospel passage Jesus describes the reciprocal relationship that exists between him and his sheep. He says: "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me" (Jn 10:27). To be a true sheep of Jesus, He invites us to "listen and follow."

It is not just about hearing the Shepherd's voice it's about listening to it and following him. He knows his sheep much better than the sheep know themselves.

Following Jesus, the Good Shepherd has a great reward; and this consists of eternal life. Jesus affirms that he receives the sheep as a gift and a commission from his Father, so no one can snatch them from his hand. At the same time, the sheep belong to the Father; if the Father and Christ are one, then his sheep have entered the dynamic of Trinitarian life. Today we also celebrate "Mother's Day." Surely many mothers will be celebrated, since it is the day when families can gather and celebrate those who have embraced us, fed us, and always waited for us. 

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week, must be requested by Wednesday of each week at office closing time or 4:00pm. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests In order for the pastor to be able to recom-

mend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ◆ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year. requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
