

III Sunday of Easter

After Jesus' resurrection, the apostles returned to their usual work, since their evangelizing work would only begin with the coming of the Holy Spirit. This is what the Holy Gospel tells us today. Peter took the initiative, saying, "I am going fishing," and the disciples who were with him answered, "We are going with you too". We must keep in mind that work is also prayer if it is offered and performed honestly. We can work without interrupting our prayer. They worked all night, but they caught absolutely nothing. When dawn broke, the risen Christ appeared to them at the shore of the lake, but they did not recognize him. He spoke to them in a very familiar way, calling out, "Children, have you caught anything?". It was only after this new miraculous catch that the apostle John, who was the youngest, recognized him.

John said to them, "It is the Lord". It was the beloved disciple who recognized Jesus. Only those who love the Lord and know they are loved by him will be able to recognize him at every step of their life.

Jesus continues speaking to them with familiar words, as he had already prepared breakfast for them. He said to them, "Come and have lunch." This is a Eucharistic sign, for John says, "He took the bread and gave it to them." My brothers and sisters, every Eucharist is a sacred banquet and a fellowship among brothers and sisters. I invite you, dear brothers and sisters, to make every meal with family or friends a gathering of joy and cordiality, just as Jesus did.

III Domenica di Pasqua Dopo la risurrezione di Gesù, gli apostoli

tornarono al loro lavoro abituale, poiché la loro opera di evangelizzazione sarebbe iniziata solo con la venuta dello Spirito Santo. Questo è ciò che il Santo Vangelo ci dice oggi. Dobbiamo tenere presente che il lavoro è anche preghiera, se offerto e compiuto con onestà. Possiamo lavorare senza interrompere la nostra preghiera. Lavorarono tutta la notte, ma non pescarono assolutamente nulla. Allo spuntare dell'alba, il Cristo risorto apparve loro sulla riva del lago, ma non lo riconobbero. Parlò loro in modo molto familiare, gridando: "Figlioli, avete preso qualcosa?". Fu solo dopo questa nuova pesca miracolosa che l'apostolo Giovanni, che era il più giovane, lo riconobbe. Giovanni disse loro: "È il Signore". Fu il discepolo amato a riconoscere Gesù. Solo chi ama il Signore e sa di essere amato da Lui potrà riconoscerlo in ogni passo della sua vita.

Gesù continua a parlare loro con parole familiari, come se avesse già preparato loro la colazione. Dice loro: "Venite a pranzare". Questo è un segno eucaristico, poiché Giovanni dice: "Prese il pane e lo diede loro". Fratelli e sorelle, ogni Eucaristia è un banchetto sacro e un momento di comunione tra fratelli e sorelle. Vi invito, cari fratelli e sorelle, a fare di ogni pasto in famiglia o con gli amici un incontro di gioia e cordialità, proprio come fece Gesù.

III Domingo de Pascua

Jesús continúa hablándoles con palabras familiares, pues ya les había preparado el desayuno. Les dijo: «Vengan a comer». Este es un signo eucarístico, pues Juan dice: «Tomó el pan y se lo dio». Hermanos y hermanas, cada Eucaristía es un banquete sagrado y una comunión fraterna. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last **name.** Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish: not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year. requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
