Sacrament of Baptism

Contact the parish at least six months before the desired date of baptism to obtain information regarding requirements and sacramental preparation, and to discuss any other concerns you may have.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, in our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

VI Sunday of Easter Love in the way Jesus loves.

"As the father loves me, so I have loved you, abide in my love." (Jn 15:9) Can anyone know how or how much the heavenly Father loves his divine Son? Jesus tells us: "This is how I love you." This is where the mystery of the Holy Trinity is no longer something distant, because although it is incomprehensible to our mind, it is an inclusive mystery, since we can see ourselves included in it. In our gospel today we find what our correspondence to the love of God should be like. Our love should not be in words or pure feeling, but in actions.

Jesus also tells us "Love one another as I have loved you." By fulfilling this commandment, we will fulfill all the others.

Jesus overflows with his love, declaring that he no longer calls them *"servants"* but rather "friends." Jesus invites us to be his friend and we will do so by doing what he commands us. How many there are who enjoy the friendship of others and do not know that they can also enjoy the friendship of Jesus, the incomparable friend! How it hurts when a friend fails us, but do not fear! The Friend par excellence will never fail you Jesus.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for a minimum of one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your reauest.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.

Parking Lot Entrances & Exit We kindly ask parishioners to utilize the parking lot entrances & exits properly. Please do not use the exit in front of the church as an entrance. You must enter from the road way closest to the school and the drive way just north of the church. As we have had many close calls lately. Thank you for your cooperation.
