



First Communion & **Confirmation Program**

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

Generosity is one of the characteristics of human beings. Created in the image and likeness of God, man becomes a reflection of God in every act of generosity. We can say that generosity humanizes us, while, on the contrary, selfishness, greed and avarice dehumanizes us. This generosity is more noticeable and even sublime when a person gives up of their substance, which is extremely necessary, especially if one is poor.

Today the Church gives us readings that invites us to reflect on generosity. In the first reading we see a widow whom the prophet Elijah asks for food, and she does not hesitate to give up what she has.
