

Sacrament of Baptism
Contact the parish at least six months before the desired date of baptism to obtain information regarding requirements and sacramental preparation, and to discuss any other concerns you may have.

Confessions
The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program
Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony
Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's Parish are asked to contact the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

Please contact the Funeral Home of your choice first. They will contact the parish office to make church arrangements. **Remember Catholic Cemeteries when making your arrangements.**

XXXIII Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Days will come when no stone will be left unturned”.

The rebuilt Jerusalem temple in 19 BC was the symbol of faith and the presence of God whom the people admired. Jesus told them there will come a day when no stone will be left upon stone. He made an Invitation to accept the brevity and fragility of human things, life included. As Christians we know that everything material is relative and temporary.

When will this event happen? Jesus took the opportunity to announce that, before he returns, there will be wars, persecution and catastrophes, but it will not be the end. All of us are exposed through natural disasters and living in violence in some countries. If we are persecuted, rejected and slandered for our beliefs or our values, we must accept it with faith, knowing that in another time and in other places today, Christians have suffered much worse. Let us not fear the second coming of Christ, which should be a reason for joy for believers and the faithful, as is expressed in the *Psalms* 96: *“Let all rejoice before the Lord, for he is coming to rule the world. Justice and righteousness shall be the standards by which he rules all nations”*

XXXIII Domenica del Tempo Ordinario

"Verranno giorni in cui non sarà lasciata pietra su pietra".

Il tempio di Gerusalemme ricostruito nel 19 a.C. era il simbolo della fede e della presenza di Dio che il popolo ammirava. Gesù disse loro che sarebbe venuto un giorno in cui non sarebbe rimasta pietra su pietra. Invitò ad accettare la brevità e la fragilità delle cose umane, vita inclusa. Come cristiani sappiamo che tutto ciò che è materiale è relativo e temporaneo.

Quando accadrà questo evento? Gesù colse l'occasione per annunciare che, prima del suo ritorno, ci saranno guerre, persecuzioni e catastrofi, ma non sarà la fine. Tutti noi siamo esposti a calamità naturali e viviamo nella violenza in alcuni paesi. Se siamo perseguitati, respinti e calunniati per le nostre convinzioni o i nostri valori, dobbiamo accettarlo con fede, sapendo che in un altro tempo e in altri luoghi, oggi, i cristiani hanno sofferto molto di più. Non temiamo la seconda venuta di Cristo, che dovrebbe essere motivo di gioia per i credenti e i fedeli, come espresso nel *Salmo* 96: *«Gioite tutti davanti al Signore, perché viene a giudicare il mondo. Giustizia e rettitudine saranno le sue norme per giudicare tutte le nazioni»*.

Si somos perseguidos, rechazados y calumniados por nuestras creencias o nuestros valores, debemos aceptarlo con fe, sabiendo que en otro tiempo y en otros lugares, los cristianos han sufrido mucho más. No temamos la segunda venida de Cristo, que debe ser motivo de alegría para los creyentes y los fieles, como se expresa en el *Salmo* 96: *«Alégrese todos delante del Señor, porque viene a gobernar el mundo. Con justicia y rectitud regirá a todas las naciones»*.

Humanitarian Relief

In recent days, two natural disasters have caused extensive damage in different parts of the world.

On Tuesday, October 28, Hurricane Melissa made landfall in Jamaica causing severe damage to both Jamaica and Haiti. Hundreds of thousands are still without power and telecommunications remain unstable. A lack of fuel and food has magnified the crisis with many homes, roads and fishing villages destroyed and thousands displaced.

On Thursday November 6, Philippine President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. declared a state of emergency in the aftermath of Typhoon Kalmaegi, which left more than 100 people dead and hundreds still unaccounted for. It is estimated that more than 500,000 people have been displaced. Those wishing to help the victims may do so in the following ways:

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week, must be requested by **Wednesday of each week at office closing time or 4:00pm**. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. **Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name**. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- ♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year. requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a recommendation letter from your Pastor.
