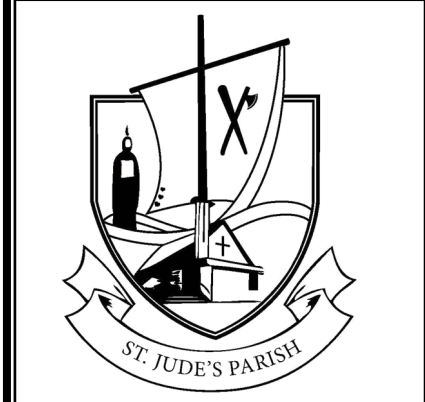

Confessions
The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program
Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony
Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

XXXI Sunday In Ordinary Time

“Which commandment is the first of all?”

In this Sunday's Gospel, a scribe, that is, an expert on the Law of Moses, asks Jesus about the first commandments.

Jesus answers by reminding him the passage from the first reading: *“Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one; you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength.”* (Dt 6:4-5; Mk 12:30).

Jesus knew this passage very well not only because he was God, but because as a true man he allowed himself to be educated by his father, St. Joseph, and his Mother Mary. St. Joseph and the Virgin Mary not only taught their Son Jesus biblical quotes, but they also educated him in the love of God and neighbor.

The love of God and our neighbor must be learned in the bosom of the home. From there, parents, loving their children, have to teach them what love means, such as obedience, respect, tolerance, forgiveness, generosity, solidarity, etc. It is at home, by the example of the parents, that children learn to love God and their neighbor. Let us continue my brothers and sisters to listen and share with others the love of God and the love to our neighbor.

XXXI Domenica Del Tempo Ordinario

“Qual è il primo di tutti i comandamenti?”

Nel Vangelo di questa domenica, uno scribe, cioè un esperto della Legge di Mosè, chiede a Gesù quali siano i primi comandamenti.

Gesù risponde ricordandogli il brano della prima lettura: *“Ascolta, Israele: il Signore è il nostro Dio, il Signore è uno solo; amerai il Signore Dio tuo con tutto il tuo cuore, con tutta la tua anima, con tutta la tua mente e con tutta la tua forza”* (Dt 6,4-5; Mc 12,30).

Gesù conosceva molto bene questo brano non solo perché era Dio, ma perché da vero uomo si è lasciato educare da suo padre, San Giuseppe, e da sua Madre Maria. San Giuseppe e la Vergine Maria non solo hanno insegnato al loro Figlio Gesù citazioni bibliche, ma lo hanno anche educato all'amore di Dio e del prossimo.

L'amore di Dio e del prossimo deve essere imparato in seno alla casa. Da lì, i genitori,

amando i loro figli, devono insegnare loro cosa significa amore, come obbedienza, rispetto, tolleranza, perdono, generosità, solidarietà, ecc. E a casa, attraverso l'esempio dei genitori, che i figli imparano ad amare Dio e il prossimo. Continuiamo, fratelli e sorelle, ad ascoltare e condividere con gli altri l'amore di Dio e l'amore per il prossimo.

XXXI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
“¿Cuál es el primero de todos los mandamientos?”

En el Evangelio de este domingo, un escriba, un experto en la Ley de Moisés pregunta a Jesús por los primeros mandamientos.

Jesús le responde recordándole el pasaje de la primera lectura: *“Escucha, Israel: El Señor nuestro Dios, el Señor es uno solo. Amarás al Señor tu Dios con todo tu corazón, con toda tu alma, con toda tu mente y con todas tus fuerzas”* (Dt 6,4-5; Mc 12,30).

Jesús conocía muy bien este pasaje no sólo porque era Dios, sino porque como verdadero hombre se dejó educar por su padre, San José, y por su madre María. San José y la Virgen María no sólo enseñaron a su Hijo Jesús citas bíblicas, sino que también lo educaron en el amor a Dios y al prójimo.

El amor a Dios y al prójimo hay que aprenderlo en el seno del hogar. Desde allí, los padres, amando a sus hijos, tienen que enseñarles lo que significa el amor, como la obediencia, el respeto, la tolerancia, el perdón, la generosidad, la solidaridad, etc. Es en casa, con el ejemplo de los padres, donde los hijos aprenden a amar a Dios y al prójimo. Sigamos, hermanos y hermanas, escuchando y compartiendo con los demás el amor de Dios y el amor al prójimo.

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week, must be requested by **Wednesday of each week.** We cannot change dates for masses previous sly requested. **Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name.** Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- ♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- ♦ Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
