XXIX Sunday In Ordinary Time

In today's holy gospel, after Jesus announces to his disciples for the third time his coming passion, death and resurrection, they still do not understand what this means. The proof of this is that the mother of James and John, approach Jesus to ask him to sit each of them in his Kingdom, one at his right and the other at his left. Jesus speaks of his rejection, suffering and terrible death, while these two think of human success.

That is why Jesus makes them see that they do not know what they are asking and asks them if they can pass the test that he himself must pass, as well as be baptized with the baptism with which he will be baptized. They very confidently answer that they can, to which Jesus prophesies that indeed, they will be able to pass that test and receive that baptism. Of course, they did not understand that it was a test of death and a baptism of blood, as in fact they were tested years later. James and John wanted to sit on the right and left of Jesus, Jesus does not want people sitting idle, but people in action.

John and James, in the light of the resurrection, understood that the true baptism is that of the blood shed to serve.

XXIX Domenica Del Tempo Ordinario

Nel santo vangelo di oggi, dopo che Gesù annuncia ai suoi discepoli per la terza volta la sua futura passione, morte e risurrezione, loro ancora non capiscono cosa significhi. La prova di ciò è che la madre di Giacomo e Giovanni, si avvicina a Gesù per chiedergli di far sedere ciascuno di loro nel suo Regno, uno alla sua destra e l'altro alla sua sinistra. Gesù parla del suo rifiuto, della sua sofferenza e della sua morte terribile, mentre questi due pensano al successo umano.

Ecco perché Gesù fa loro vedere che non sanno cosa stanno chiedendo e chiede loro se possono superare la prova che lui stesso deve superare, oltre a essere battezzati con il battesimo con cui sarà battezzato lui. Rispondono con molta sicurezza che possono, al che Gesù profetizza che in effetti saranno in grado di superare quella prova e ricevere quel battesimo. Naturalmente, non capirono che si trattava di una prova di morte e di un battesimo di sangue, come in effetti furono messi alla

prova anni dopo. Giacomo e Giovanni volevano sedersi alla destra e alla sinistra di Gesù, Gesù non vuole persone sedute inerti, ma persone in azione. Giovanni e Giacomo, alla luce della risurrezione, hanno compreso che il vero battesimo è quello del sangue versato per servire.

XXIX Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

En el santo evangelio de hoy, después de que Jesús anuncia a sus discípulos por tercera vez su próxima pasión, muerte y resurrección, ellos aún no entienden lo que esto significa. La prueba de ello es que la madre de Santiago y Juan, se acercan a Jesús para pedirle que los sienta a cada uno en su Reino, uno a su derecha y el otro a su izquierda. Jesús habla de su rechazo, sufrimiento y muerte terrible, mientras estos dos piensan en el éxito humano.

Por eso Jesús les hace ver que no saben lo que piden y les pregunta si pueden pasar la prueba que él mismo debe pasar, así como ser bautizados con el bautismo con el que él será bautizado. Ellos muy confiados responden que sí pueden, a lo que Jesús profetiza que efectivamente, podrán pasar esa prueba y recibir ese bautismo. Por supuesto, ellos no entendían que se trataba de una prueba de muerte y un bautismo de sangre, como de hecho fueron probados años después. Santiago y Juan querían sentarse a la derecha y a la izquierda de Jesús, Jesús no quiere gente sentada ociosa, sino gente en acción.

Juan y Santiago, a la luz de la resurrección, comprendieron que el verdadero bautismo es el de la sangre derramada para servir.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- ♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- ♦ Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request. It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.

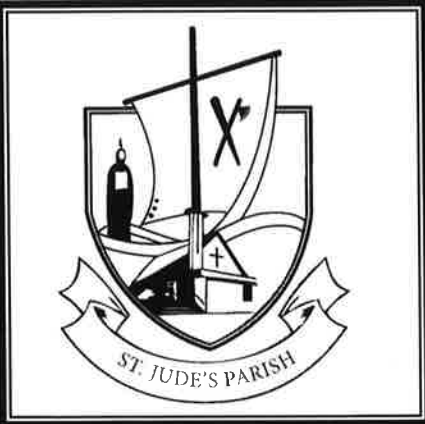

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.
