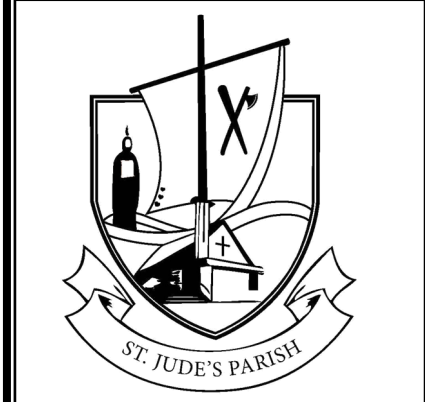

Confessions

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.

XXX Sunday In Ordinary Time

"Jesus, son of David, have mercy on me"

This is the cry that the blind man from Jericho, Bartimeus, makes to Jesus. This cry is a cry of desperation, of being healed, and at the same time it is the cry of a confession of faith in Jesus. By recognizing that Jesus is the son of David the blind man also recognized that Jesus is the long-awaited Messiah, able to heal him. The people rebuked the blind man because his cries bothered them. We too can find in our lives people who want to silence our voice that cries out in search of the Lord; that is why we need to persevere like Bartimeus and overcome the obstacles of those who want to stop our search.

Jesus ordered the disciples to bring to him the blind man, and someone call out to him, "Get up, He is calling you." Perhaps your task, if you already see with the light of Christ, is to go and call others to come to meet Him, and to tell them: "Cheer up! Get up, Jesus is calling you." my brothers and sisters let us bring Jesus to those who are spiritually blind so that they may have that healing encounter that only Jesus can give.

Just as the blind man once recovered his vision joyfully followed Jesus, let us also continue walking with our Lord who always passes in front of us.

Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
♦ Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.
