

XXVII Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Holy Gospel, Jesus teaches the apostles the importance of faith and service to God. According to St. Luke, the Apostles ask Jesus to increase their faith. And you, would you ask Jesus to increase your faith? Or do you think you already have enough? There are people who think they have faith, although what they have is optimism that things should go well for them. Many times, I have heard that when faced with a problem or illness there are people who say: "I have to be well, as God is very good", but the truth is that if things don't go well, if we continue to be sick, God continues to be good.

The one who has true faith is not the one who trusts that God will solve his problems, but the one who trusts that no matter what happens, God remains with him, even in the worst moments. The man and woman of faith are those who abandon themselves in the hands of God our Father and always pray asking like Jesus in the Garden of Olives: "But not according to my will, but according to yours." Whoever has faith prays the Our Father seriously, believing every word he says: "Lord, thy will be done".

Today, let us all ask him to increase our faith. The Lord is not going to deny us this gift that he wants to offer everyone. But you must

Mass Intentions

Mass intentions to be announced on weekend masses and the following week, must be requested by Wednesday of each week at office closing time or 4:00pm. We cannot change dates for masses previously requested. Each mass intention can include up to two individual names with the same last name. Thank you for your understanding and your co-operation.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- Be in the parish for participation in Sun day/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year. requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a recommendation letter from your Pastor.
