**XXVII Sunday In Ordinary Time**

*"What God has joined together, let no one separate."*

This Sunday's readings speak about marriage and divorce. In the Gospel, Jesus is questioned about the legality of divorce. He tells us that although Moses allowed divorce because of the hardness of people's hearts, that was not God's original plan. Jesus reminds us that the Creator made them male and female. In this passage, we see the complementarity of people. In the first reading, taken from the Book of Genesis, man searches for someone like him among all the animals and finds no one (cf. Gen 2:18-24). Then God our Creator put Adam to sleep and from his side close to his heart He forms the woman. When Adam saw her, he **exclaimed "This is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh."**

The teaching that this passage leaves us is that of the similarity between man and woman, their equality in dignity and their reciprocal complementarity. That is why husband, and wife must always seek dialogue and just as God does not divorce his children, the dialogue between spouses must never end. I invite you to always value marriage and family. All of us, thank God, were born from a father and a mother, from a family. Let us pray this Sunday for the marriages in our community, especially for those who are going through difficulties, so that dialogue between them will never be lacking.

**XXVII Domenica Del Tempo Ordinario**

*"Quello che Dio ha unito, l'uomo non lo separi".*

Le lettere di questa domenica parlano di matrimonio e divorzio. Nel Vangelo, Gesù viene interrogato sulla legalità del divorzio. Ci dice che, sebbene Mosè abbia permesso il divorzio a causa della durezza del cuore delle persone, quello non era il piano originale di Dio. Gesù ci ricorda che il Creatore li ha creati maschio e femmina. In questo brano, vediamo la complementarietà delle persone. Nella prima lettura, tratta dal Libro della Genesi, l'uomo cerca qualcuno come lui tra tutti gli animali e non trova nessuno (cf. Gen 2,18-24). Allora Dio nostro Creatore addormentò Adamo e dal suo costato vicino al cuore formò la donna. Quando Adamo la vide, esclamò: **"Questa è carne dalla mia carne e osso dalle mie ossa"**.

L'insegnamento che questo brano ci lascia è quello della somiglianza tra uomo e donna, della loro uguaglianza nella dignità e della loro reciproca complementarietà. Ecco perché marito e moglie devono sempre cercare il dialogo e proprio come Dio non divorzia dai suoi figli, il dialogo tra gli sposi non deve mai finire. Vi invito a valorizzare sempre il matrimonio e la famiglia. Tutti noi, grazie a Dio, siamo nati da un padre e una madre, da una famiglia. Preghiamo questa domenica per i matrimoni

della nostra comunità, specialmente per quelli che stanno attraversando difficoltà, perché non manchi mai il dialogo tra loro.

**XXVII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario**

*"Lo que Dios ha unido, que no lo separe el hombre".*

Las lecturas de este domingo hablan sobre el matrimonio y el divorcio. En el Evangelio, Jesús es interrogado sobre la legalidad del divorcio. Él nos dice que, aunque Moisés permitió el divorcio a causa de la dureza de corazón de las personas, ese no era el plan original de Dios. Jesús nos recuerda que el Creador los hizo hombre y mujer. En este pasaje vemos el complemento del uno con el otro. En la primera lectura, tomada del libro del Génesis, el hombre busca entre todos los animales a alguien que se le parezca y no lo encuentra (cf. Gn 2,18-24). Entonces Dios nuestro Creador hizo dormir a Adán y de su costado, cerca de su corazón, formó a la mujer. Cuando Adán la vio, exclamó: **"Ésta es hueso de mis huesos y carne de mi carne"**.

La enseñanza que nos deja este pasaje es la de la semejanza entre el hombre y la mujer, su igualdad en dignidad y el complemento mutuo. Por eso, marido y mujer deben buscar siempre el diálogo y, así como Dios no se divorcia de sus hijos, el diálogo entre los esposos no debe terminar nunca. Os invito a valorar siempre el matrimonio y la familia. Todos nosotros, gracias a Dios, nacimos de un padre y una madre, de una familia. Oremos este domingo por los matrimonios de nuestra comunidad, especialmente por aquellos que están pasando por dificultades, para que nunca falte el diálogo entre ellos.

**Consolata Missionares Canada**

On Oct. 20, the world celebrates Mission Sunday, and on this special day, Pope Francis will canonize Blessed Joseph Allamano, founder of the Consolata Missionaries.

In addition to the ceremony in Rome, we will celebrate this joyous occasion locally at **St. Andrew's Parish, 2547 Kipling Ave.** On the day of the canonization, a Solemn Mass will be held at 10:30am., presided by His Grace Francis Leo, the Archbishop of Toronto, a long-time friend of the Consolata Missionaries since his youth in Montreal.

Blessed Joseph Allamano was an Italian Catholic priest known for his spiritual guidance, missionary work and contributions to priestly education. He founded the Consolata Missionaries and emphasized excellence in missionary efforts, deep devotion to Our Lady Consolata and the importance of holiness and obedience in all actions. Allamano valued truth, sincerity and relationships built on integrity, while promoting continuous spiritual formation for priests. His legacy endures through the Consolata Missionaries and his teachings on virtue and missionary dedication.

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- ◆ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- ◆ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ◆ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- ◆ Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.

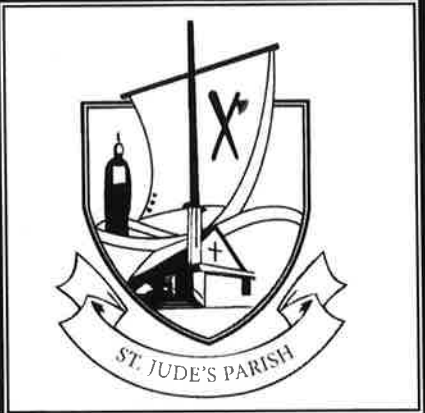

## Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.
