**XXVI Sunday In Ordinary Time**

*"If your hand is an occasion of sin...If your foot is an occasion...If your eyes are...cut it out"*

In the Gospel today, Jesus is speaking to us about how our senses can lead us to sin, and he is speaking to us symbolically, because even if we take out one of our eyes, we could still sin. Jesus is not encouraging physical mutilation. Instead, he is telling us that we must take practical, sometimes even extreme, measures to avoid sin.

Jesus does not want our feet to walk toward places of sin, our eyes to live the lust of desire, revenge, the thirst for evil, our hands to do wrong things.

But feet to follow Jesus to walk with him toward life, feet to make a path with everyone.

Eyes to see the beauty of God's creation, eyes to see Jesus in our brothers and sisters created in the image of God.

Hands to worship, to bless, to embrace, and to do good.

**Consolata Missionares Canada**

On Oct. 20, the world celebrates Mission Sunday, and on this special day, Pope Francis will canonize Blessed Joseph Allamano, founder of the Consolata Missionaries. Our congregation has faithfully served the archdiocese for many years, and we are currently overseeing the parish of Saint Andrew in Etobicoke.

In addition to the ceremony in Rome, we will celebrate this joyous occasion locally at **St. Andrew's Parish, 2547 Kipling Ave.** On the day of the canonization, a Solemn Mass will be held at 10:30am., presided by His Grace Francis Leo, the Archbishop of Toronto, a long-time friend of the Consolata Missionaries since his youth in Montreal.

Blessed Joseph Allamano was an Italian Catholic priest known for his spiritual guidance, missionary work and contributions to priestly education. He founded the Consolata Missionaries and emphasized excellence in missionary efforts, deep devotion to Our Lady Consolata and the importance of holiness and obedience in all actions. Allamano valued truth, sincerity and relationships built on integrity, while promoting continuous spiritual formation for priests. His legacy endures through the Consolata Missionaries and his teachings on virtue and missionary dedication.

**Pastoral Reference Requests**

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude's:

- ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- ♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- ♦ Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request.

It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.

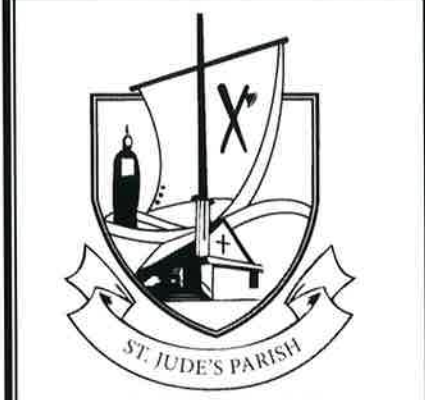
