XXIII Sunday In Ordinary Time

Effetá, “*be Open*” was the word that Jesus said to the deaf and mute man. This same word is pronounced during the sacrament of baptism. “*Effetá*” (be Open!), the priest or deacon who baptizes, makes the sign of the cross on the child’s ears and on his mouth, while he says: “*The Lord Jesus Christ, who made the deaf hear...*” and then he makes the sign of the cross on the lips of the baptized person and continues saying: “*...and the mute to speak may he soon touch your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his faith, to the praise and glory of God the Father*”, Amen You, as a baptized person, are called to listen to the Word of God and to proclaim the Gospel where? everywhere but especially in the Holy Eucharist that is proclaimed every Sunday. I invite you, dear brothers and sisters, not to be deaf or mute to the Gospel. Let us keep our ears open to listen to God, to listen to the message of Jesus, the message of eternal life. Let us be active in our commitment as baptized people for the glory of God the Father.

XXIII Domenica Del Tempo Ordinario

Effetá, “*sii aperto*” è la parola che Gesù disse al sordomuto. Vogliamo essere attivi nel nostro impegno di battezzati per la gloria di Dio Padre.

XXIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Effetá, “*Abrete*” fue la palabra que Jesús le dijo al sordomudo. Esta misma palabra se pronuncia durante el sacramento del bau-

tismo. “*Effetá*” (¡Abrete!), el sacerdote o el diácono que bautiza hace la señal de la cruz en los oídos y en la boca del niño, mientras dice: “*El Señor Jesucristo, que hizo oír a los sordos...*” y luego hace la señal de la cruz en los labios del bautizado y continúa diciendo: “*...y al mudo a hablar que pronto toque tus oídos para recibir su palabra, y tu boca para proclamar su fe, para alabanza y gloria de Dios Padre*”, Amén.

Tú, como bautizado, estás llamado a escuchar la Palabra de Dios y a anunciar el Evangelio ¿dónde? En todas partes, pero especialmente en la Sagrada Eucaristía que se proclama cada domingo. Os invito, queridos hermanos y hermanas, a no ser sordos ni mudos al Evangelio. Mantengamos los oídos abiertos para escuchar a Dios, para escuchar el mensaje de Jesús, el mensaje de vida eterna. Seamos activos en nuestro compromiso como bautizados para la gloria de Dios Padre.

Pastoral Reference Requests

In order for the pastor to be able to recommend you, he needs to know you. This is only possible if he has personal knowledge of your faith practice and involvement in the parish; not your relatives, but yourself, as this is a personal recommendation.

The following are required at St. Jude’s:

- ♦ Be (yourself, not your parents or grandparents) a registered member of the parish using offertory envelopes for at least one year.
- ♦ Be in the parish for participation in Sunday/Saturday mass for at least one year prior to approaching the pastor.
- ♦ Applicant must be actively involved in a parish ministry or volunteer activity for a least one year.
- ♦ Please ensure that you meet these requirements before making your request. It is important for you to know that to be hired to teach in any Catholic School Board in Ontario as part of your application for employment you must provide a letter of recommendation from your Pastor.

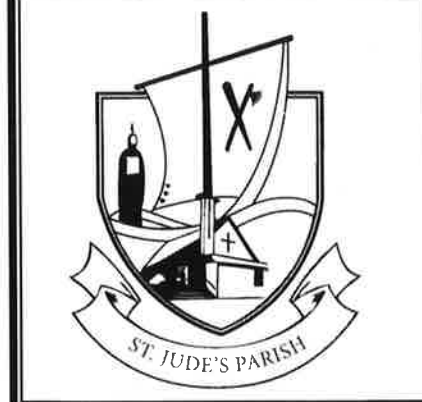

Confessions

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available Saturdays at 4:00pm - 4:45pm and other times by appointment.

First Communion & Confirmation Program

Parents are asked to contact the office for information. Our programs begin in the fall (September or October) and end with the reception of the sacraments. Registration dates are announced in the bulletin, on our website, social media, and from the pulpit.

Sacrament of Matrimony

Couples contemplating marriage at St. Jude's parish are required to make contact with the parish office and review the marriage package before an interview with the priest. Diocesan regulation demands that marriages are booked one year in advance minimum.
